Patrick S. Cheng is the Assistant Professor of Historical and Systematic Theology at the Episcopal Divinity School in Cambridge, MA. Patrick's scholarly work relates to the theological intersections of race, sexuality, and gender. He is the founder of Queer Asian Spirit, an organization by and for LGBTQ Asian people of faith. He is also a contributor to the Huffington Post, and he serves as an ordained minister with the queer-positive Metropolitan Community Churches. Patrick received his Ph.D. from Union Theological Seminary in New York City, and he also holds a J.D. from Harvard Law School and B.A. from Yale College. Patrick's book on queer theology, Radical Love: An Introduction to Queer Theology, is published by Seabury Books. This spring, Patrick will be delivering the Fourth Annual John E. Boswell lecture at the Center for Lesbian and Gay Studies in Religion and Ministry at the Pacific School of Religion.


