An hour-long teleconference with **Rev. Dr. Eleanor Moody-Shepherd**

WATER is pleased to present the <u>Rev. Dr. Eleanor</u> <u>Moody-Shepherd</u>, an ordained Minister in the Presbyterian Church. She currently serves as Vice President for Academic Affairs at New York Theological Seminary. She also serves as their Academic Dean and teaches as a Professor of Women's Studies. She leads study seminars to various parts of the world including the Holy Land, Africa, and the U.S. South. Domestic violence, women in leadership, and women in the Bible are the main areas with which her teaching and research are concerned. She acts as an educational consultant, motivational speaker, and preacher for numerous local organizations and churches.

Eleanor will speak about the voices, observations, and interpretations of black women who practice ministry and/or are connected with New York seminaries. She will begin with her chapter in <u>New Feminist Christianity</u> entitled "Our Voices: Loud and Clear." She will continue and expand the conversation with new insights from subsequent research and teaching.

This is a great opportunity for students as well as for ministers and others interested in new insights in the field of women and religion. It is sure to be an engrossing session.
